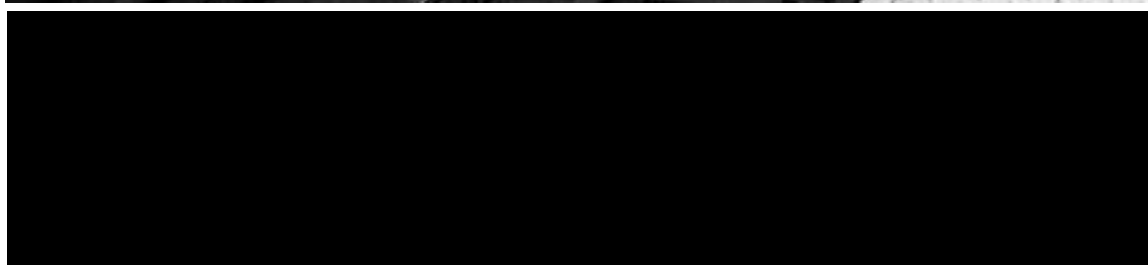
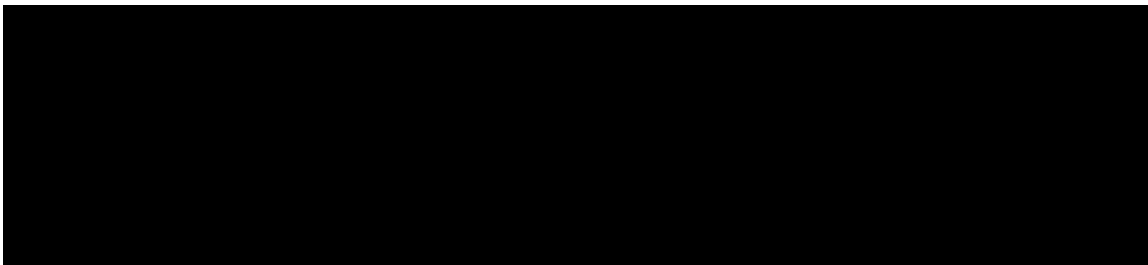

TRANSPORTATION FEATURES AND SERVICES

Features of Accessible Stations

The MTA network has more than 75 fully accessible subway and commuter rail stations. These stations have features that improve accessibility for customers with visual, hearing, and mobility impairments, as specified by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Their features include:

- elevators or ramps
- handrails on ramps and stairs
- large -print and tactile-Braille signs
- audio and visual information systems
- accessible station booth windows
- accessible MetroCard Vending Machines
- accessible service entry gates at subway stations
- platform gap modifications or bridge plates to reduce or eliminate the gap between trains and platforms

the base of the screen.

Boarding, Riding, and Leaving Trains

To ensure that you have a safe, comfortable, and convenient ride, follow these guidelines:

- Wait for the train near the center of the platform, where the car with the conductor normally stops. An overhead striped sign usually designates this area. The conductor can be helpful in providing travel information.
- All fully accessible and renovated stations have two-foot-wide yellow tactile edge-warning strips. Make sure that you stay behind these strips until it is time to board the train.
- If you are in a wheelchair, position it about three feet from the edge of the platform and facing the tracks, with brakes locked. Never position your wheelchair between a station column and the platform edge. This creates an obstacle to passenger flow and is a safety hazard for you and the other passengers.

- At most stations there is a gap, about four inches wide and two inches high, between the platform edge and the subway car; on curved platforms the space is more significant. Please be extra careful when crossing these gaps. (The vertical gap on accessible subway station platforms is lower only near the center of the platform, near the conductor's position)
- Once on board, position your wheelchair close to either end of the car and near but not blocking the doors. Remember to lock your brakes.
- If you miss your stop at an accessible station, stay on the train until you reach a station where you can transfer on the same platform to a train in the opposite direction and ride back to the station you missed.

Tactile-Braille Subway Maps

NYC Transit and the Baruch College Computer Center for Visually Impaired People have produced a series of raised-line Braille maps with large-

print backup for each subway line. Tactile-Braille overview maps of each borough and station maps for 66th Street-Lincoln Center, Roosevelt Avenue-74th Street, Jay Street-Borough Hall and 59th Street-Lexington Avenue are also available. These maps are free. To order call 1-646-252-5031. Your order will arrive in six to eight weeks.

Tactile Signage and Visual Displays

- All fully accessible stations and newly renovated stations have tactile-Braille signage that is located on the left side of the station both and on the platform columns nearest the stairs as well as on other columns throughout the station.

Accessible Buses

New York City Transit and Long Island Bus serve local and express bus routes throughout the five boroughs and in Nassau and western Suffolk counties. These routes connect with many subway and commuter rail stations, as well as key transportation hubs.

The more than 4,300 buses in NYC

Transit's fleet are equipped with wheelchair lifts and have a "kneeling" feature that lowers the front entrance of the vehicle to within inches from the ground for easy access by any customer with mobility impairments or difficulty using the front steps.

Personal Care Attendants

Personal Care Attendants (PCAs-people employed to assist individuals with disabilities) are eligible to ride the subway system free when accompanying a person who is carrying a paratransit card that designates PCA assistance is required.

Service Animals

Customers with disabilities are permitted to bring their service animals into all MTA transit facilities. The animals must be securely leashed for the safety of all customers.

Boarding, Riding, and Leaving the Bus

Customers with disabilities are permitted to bring their service animals into all MTA transit facilities. The animals must be securely leashed for the safety of all customers.

- Wait near the bus stop sign where the driver can see you and you can signal to the driver.
- Make sure you have the correct bus by checking the front destination sign, listening to the recorded announcements on many LI Bus vehicles and some NYC Transit vehicles, or asking the driver.
- The driver will position the bus to deploy the lift safely or operate the kneeling feature

- Priority seating for customers with disabilities and senior citizens is located behind the driver. Other passengers must make these seats available upon request. Please remember that some passengers may have disabilities that are not visible.

New York City is famous for its yellow (medallion) taxicabs, and hailing one is how many people prefer to travel. All medallion taxicab drivers are required to assist persons with disabilities, and are trained to do so. They must also not engage the meter until a disabled passenger is settled in and ready to go, and must secure the wheelchair or other mobility aid in the vehicle. Also, New York City



While some medallion taxicabs are wheelchair accessible, most passengers find that it is easier to pre-arrange an accessible trip through the city's comprehensive network of for-hire (livery) vehicles, which must provide accessible service on request as of October 31, 2001. Each for-hire vehicle must either provide an accessible vehicle, or arrange for the dispatch of an accessible vehicle from another licensed base. Accessible vehicles must be made available at the same cost, and with the same availability, as service is provided to non-disabled passengers. One popular service, Symphony Transportation (available 24 hours a day, seven days a week at 1-800-253-1443) is a cooperative effort of Easter Seals of New York and the Executive Transportation Group, while others are well represented in published telephone listings and on the worldwide web. 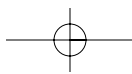
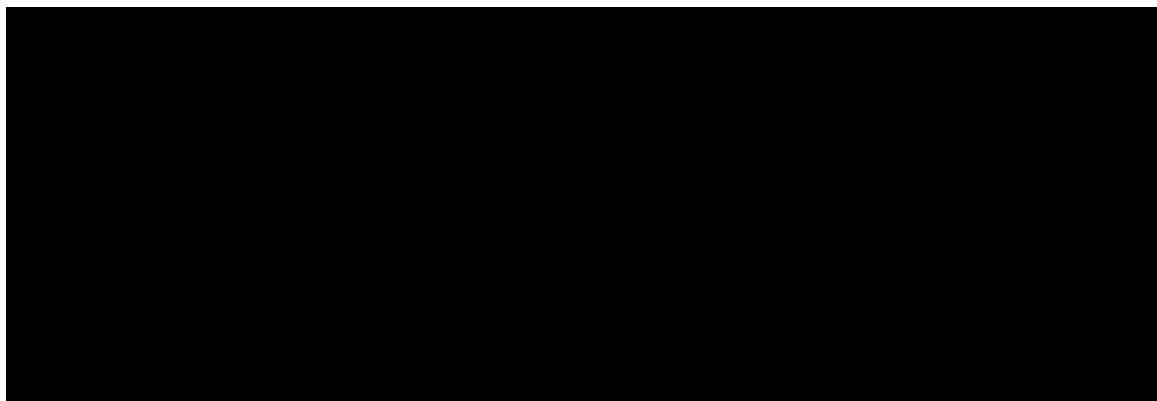
